### **Procedures and Guidelines**

The following procedures and guidelines have been established for the After-School Enrichment programs sponsored by the Sharon Public Schools for the 2021-2022 school year:

We now offer the ability to <u>register and pay online through our website</u> at <u>www.sharoncommunityeducation.com</u>. There is **no** fee for this payment service. All families, if you haven't already done so, must create an account for your child to be registered for enrichment, as this is the method for taking attendance. Payment is required at time of registration.

If you have questions regarding any of these programs, please contact the Community Education Office, 77 Pond Street, Sharon, 781-784-1574, between the hours of 9:15 AM and 4:30 PM.

Acceptance will be on a first-come/first-serve basis. Should a class sell out a waiting list will be created.

Each program has been scheduled according to the instructor's availability, as well as the facility in which the class will be held.

Activities are run only if the school is in session with the exception of classes such as Ice Skating and Kumon as they are held at outside venues. Classes are usually not scheduled on Early Release Days. In the event of postponement, due to weather conditions or instructor unavailability, class may be extended at the end of the scheduled session.

Snack is <u>not</u> provided. Students attending an enrichment session should bring a snack from home.

The Sharon Public Schools reserves the right to terminate or limit a child's attendance in a program when, in the judgment of the staff, the child's behavior is inappropriate.

All programs are covered under the Town of Sharon's liability insurance policy while the programs are in session and are held on Town property. Outside venues are covered by their own policies.

All After-School Enrichment Programs must be pre-paid in full and all waivers **MUST** be completed and submitted. Waivers are found online at the time of registration. They can be completed online and emailed to us or may be printed out and mailed to our office.

If a child misses the Community Education Van for any reason, parents, then emergency contacts will be notified, and they are responsible for driving the child to the program.

It is the responsibility of the parents or guardians to notify the Community Education office at 781-784-1574 prior to 2:00 PM, if their child will be absent from the class. Communication with the child's school does not reach us.

Children are expected to ride on the Community Education Van to all the Enrichment Programs. If you choose to drive your child, stay with them, and drive them home, you must notify our office of this alternate transportation for each occurrence.

If a student has an outstanding tuition balance in any Community Education Program, he/she will not be eligible to participate in additional Community Education Programs, until the balance is paid.

Failure to pick up your child by the time indicated in the program description will result in a penalty fee of \$5.00 for <u>each</u> five-minute interval.

Refunds of registration fees are processed when classes are canceled dependent on status of class. Refunds for withdrawals after the start of programs will require approval from Community Education Office and the Instructor and may be subject to a processing fee.





In this mini course, you will perform exercises similar to the training of real NASA astronauts-



We will practice training with an actual NASA curriculum that was designed to teach about strength, agility and cardiovascular endurance.

There will even be crew survival challenges enhancing social emotional learning. We will have the opportunity to design and fly water rockets, and study the effects of gravity on the human body.

An integral part of the class will be the assembling of NASA provided cardstock models, enabling the students to explore and study the latest in space flight vehicles.

LEGO ADVENTURES Grades 2-5 Are you a Lego master? If so, it's time to show off your skills! Each week in Lego Adventures, there is a new challenge we must face: from skyscrapers to farms, bridges to airports, space stations to main streets, and everything in between! First, our Right Brain Curriculum instructors will review the history of what we are about to build: How the invention of the elevator revolutionized city skylines, how farms in the 1930s survived hordes of grasshoppers and the Dust Bowl, how aeroelasticity explains why the Tacoma bridge is nicknamed "Galloping Gertie" collapsed, etc. Then, it's time to build! You will create a model of each type of structure out of an enormous assortment of provided Legos, and of course, we thoroughly photograph each creation before we move on to our next topic. In our final week, you will create a final project landmark to show visiting parents (along with photos of your previous creations). Learning and Legos: A perfect match!

They utilize skills including: Multiplication and Division; Budgeting and Money; Geometry; Perimeter, and Area; Measuring and Estimation; Fractions and Decimals; Probability; Basic Algebraic Concepts. Students will construct houses, skyscrapers, bridges and more while fulfilling specified mathematical requirements. Students will create project blueprints before each project and solve word-problems upon completion. They share and show off their projects to the class. It's the perfect way for students to apply what they learn!

FUTUREHOUSE Grades 2-5 Students create a house that will exist a century from now! What will life on Earth be like a century from now? In our Future House class, students imagine and design a Lego model of a home they design for the year 2118. First, they study what daily life was like one hundred years ago and then pivot to consider how life might change one hundred years in the future. They study the writings of futurists, learn about new "smart homes" and consider what phones, stoves, sofas, televisions and cars might look like a century from now. Students use math, writing and presentation skills as they draw up an extensive blueprint of their future house, compose a "Day in the Life" story that takes place in 2118 and work with geometric calculations as they design their blueprint. Time travel may not really be possible but our Future House students will find themselves in a different time and place!






