Procedures and Guidelines

The following procedures and guidelines have been established for the After-School Enrichment programs sponsored by the Sharon Public Schools for the 2022-2023 school year:

We now offer the ability to **register and pay online through our website** at <u>www.sharoncommunityeducation.com</u>. There is **no** fee for this payment service. All families, if you haven't already done so, must create an account for the family and add the child to be registered for enrichment, as this is the method for taking attendance. Payment is required at time of registration.

If you have questions regarding any of these programs, please contact the Community Education Office, 181 Pond Street, Sharon, 781-784-1574, between the hours of 9:15 AM and 4:30 PM.

Acceptance will be on a first-come/first-serve basis. Should a class sell out a waiting list will be created.

Each program has been scheduled according to the instructor's availability, as well as the facility in which the class will be held.

Activities are run only if the school is in session with the exception of classes such as Ice Skating, Tennis, Horsemanship, and Kumon as they are held at outside venues. Classes are usually not scheduled on Early Release Days. In the event of postponement, due to weather conditions or instructor unavailability, class may be extended at the end of the scheduled session.

Snacks are **<u>not</u>** provided. Students attending an enrichment session should bring a snack from home.

The Sharon Public Schools reserves the right to terminate or limit a child's attendance in a program when, in the judgment of the staff, the child's behavior is inappropriate.

All programs are covered under the Town of Sharon's liability insurance policy while the programs are in session and are held on Town property. Outside venues are covered by their own policies.

All After-School Enrichment Programs must be pre-paid in full and all waivers **MUST** be completed and submitted. Waivers are found online at the time of registration. Also, document upload is available. They can be completed online and emailed to us or may be printed out and mailed to our office.

If a child misses the Community Education Van for any reason, parents, then emergency contacts will be notified, and they are responsible for driving the child to the program.

It is the responsibility of the parents or guardians to notify the Community Education office at 781-784-1574 prior to 2:00 PM, if their child will be absent from the class. Communication with the child's school does not reach us.

Children are expected to ride on the Community Education Van to all the Enrichment Programs. If you choose to drive your child, stay with them, and drive them home, you must notify our office of this alternate transportation for <u>each</u> occurrence.

If a student has an outstanding tuition balance in any Community Education Program, he/she will not be eligible to participate in additional Community Education Programs, until the balance is paid.

Failure to pick up your child by the time indicated in the program description will result in a penalty fee of \$5.00 for <u>each</u> five-minute interval.

Refunds of registration fees are processed when classes are canceled dependent on status of class. Refunds for withdrawals after the start of programs will require approval from Community Education Office and the Instructor and may be subject to a processing fee.

ACADEMICS

<u>Kumon</u>: MATH Grades 1-5

ACADEMICS

Sharon High School Help Desk Grade 5

Sharon High School students created this program as a part of their "Help Desk class." High School students will be running the class and supervised by district staff for the duration of the course. Please note that this class is only being offered to 5th grade students.

Through hands-on projects and collaboration, students will be introduced to intriguing mathematical concepts and problem solving techniques not typically taught in school. Students will gain a deeper appreciation for math, understand why it is useful for various fields, and hone their creative-thinking skills, which they can use in STEM in the future. Topics include the art of estimation, number theory, introductory game theory, and more!

LEGO ADVENTURES Grades 2-5

Are you a Lego master? If so, it's time to show off your skills! Each week in Lego Adventures, there is a new challenge we must face: from skyscrapers to farms, bridges to airports, space stations to main streets, and everything in between! First, our Right Brain Curriculum instructors will review the history of what we are about to build: how the invention of the elevator revolutionized city skylines, how farms in the 1930s survived hordes of grasshoppers and the Dust Bowl, how aero elasticity explains why the Tacoma bridge is nicknamed "Galloping Gertie" collapsed, etc. Then, it's time to build! There will even be crew survival challenges enhancing social emotional learning. We will have the opportunity to design and fly water rockets, and study the effects of gravity on the human body. An integral part of the class will be the assembling of NASA provided cardstock models, enabling the students to explore and study the latest in space flight vehicles.


ADULT EDUCATION
